Requested Action: Appoint Brad Barker as a Citizen-At-Large to the Marion County Solid Waste Management Advisory Council.

Issue, Description & Background: Brad Barker has expressed interest to serve on the SWMAC as a Citizen-At-Large. We will be seeking action at the November 29 Board Session; there are no additional applicants for the Council position. The SWMAC Nominations Subcommittee conducted an interview with Brad Barker for a Citizen-At-Large position, on September 12. The SWMAC Nominations Subcommittee moved to recommend appointing Brad during their regular meeting, on September 26. The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry. The terms of the individual positions are four-year terms. The SWMAC is a public body which, under its bylaws, makes recommendations to the Marion County Board of Commissioners. County policy and the SWMAC by-laws require that the Marion County Board of Commissioners make the final appointments.
