WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statute 215.050 authorizes the governing body to revise the zoning code; and
WHEREAS, Section 17.110.840 of the Marion County Code authorize the Board of Commissioners to initiate a legislative amendment to the text of the zoning code; and
WHEREAS, recent legislation allows the county to permit accessory dwelling units in the Acreage Residential zone; and
WHEREAS, the Marion County Board of Commissioners has determined that consideration of this zoning code amendment is in the general public interest; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Commissioners hereby initiates consideration of an amendment to Chapter 17 of the Marion County Code; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby schedules a public hearing to receive testimony on the proposed amendment for 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 25, 2023, at the Senator Hearing Room, 1 st floor, Courthouse Square Building, 555 Court Street NE, Salem.
