Requested Action:

Staff request Board approval of the reappointments of Brian Sund and Will Posegate, each for a four-year term, on the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council in the Citizen-at-Large and Recycling Industry Representative positions, respectively, beginning February 7, 2024, and ending December 31, 2027.

Issue, Description & Background:

The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989, as a public body to provide them with advice and recommendations. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry. The county's policy and SWMAC bylaws require the board of commissioners make all membership appointments, and the terms of the individual positions are for four years. Brian Sund, with 16 years on the SWMAC, brings significant input, particularly in education. Currently a Citizen-at-Large, he has served as Chair and Vice-Chair twice. Will Posegate, a member for seven years, holds the Recycling Industry representative position. As the COO for Garten Services and a Marion County Master Recycler, Will's contribution is invaluable.
