TITLE Tax Collector Appointment

Issue, Description & Background The current Marion County Tax Collector has retired and a new Tax Collector must be appointed by the Board of Commissioners per ORS 311.055. Natasha McVey, a 15 year employee of the Tax Office, and newly promoted Tax Office Supervisor is the top candidate.
