- 1. Consider approval of a resolution of desire to participate in the 2015-2017 Community Dispute Resolution Program grant selection process. Tamra Goettsch, Ted Schuster *Summary of Presentation:*
 - Resolution is for a two-year period;
 - Allows Marion County to be the administrator of Community Dispute Resolution Program;
 - Mr. Schuster will assist in administration of contract;
 - Helps community members avoid legal action and use mediation services;
 - Resolution is first step in identifying who would coordinate process and contract;
 - \$84,371 administered to a grantee chosen through a Request for Application (RFA) process beginning July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017;

- Funds would be administered through the University of Oregon School of Law on Marion County's behalf; and
- No funding would flow through Marion County.

Board discussion:

- County has long history using dispute resolution working with Neighbor to Neighbor;
- RFA's opened every two years; and
- Departments that have used the dispute resolution process include Planning, Code Enforcement, and Juvenile.
