**TITLE** Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) Member Appointment

**Issue, Description & Background**

The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989. The SWMAC is a public body that was formed by the Board of Commissioners to make recommendations to the Marion County Board of Commissioners. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry. The terms of the individual positions are for four years.

Tim Rice is the facilities manager for Recology Organics- Aumsville. He is an expert on composting and recycling. Tim strives to improve and simplify recycling and composting in his community by bringing his personal knowledge and expertise to the SWMAC.

April Murazzo is an Environmental Protection Specialist for the Oregon Military Department. Solid waste, education, and citizen engagement are her passions. She believes in taking a systematic approach to meeting waste reduction goals.

The SWMAC recommends Tim Rice and April Murazzo to be appointed to join the council in the citizen-at-large positions for four year terms beginning April 24, 2018.

1. Accept the appointments as recommended by SWMAC.
2. Do not accept the appointment and direct staff to search for other individuals to fill these positions on the SWMAC.
