2. Land Trust Discussion

County counsel discussed a property in NE Salem that may be going into land trust in order to better facilitate future construction. He asked the board if they wished to submit comment, the board declined.

3. Property Acquisition

Brian discussed the property acquisition strategy for the water campus project, which involves obtaining permanent easements from Pacific Northwest Veg and Lineage Master for three parcels. The Board requested expedited review of the Pacific Northwest Veg purchase and sale agreement for next week's board meeting, while ongoing negotiations with Lineage Master are addressing their concerns about temporary easements and property tax implications. Marion expressed preference for the board to approve the easements on consent agenda to avoid complexity in public discussions.
