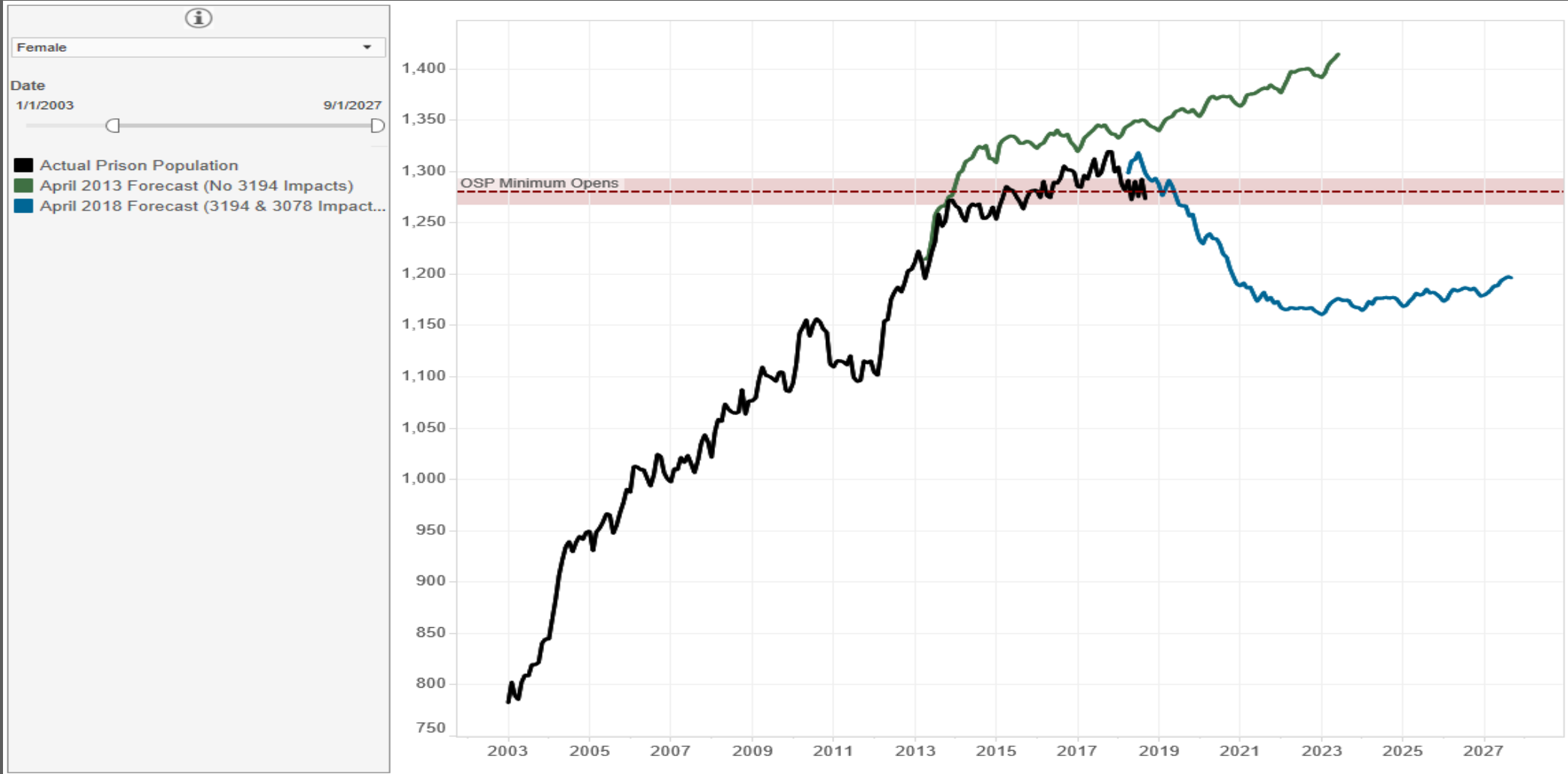
# Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant

- Created by SB 1544 (2018 Session)
- \$1.5 Million in 17-19 biennium, \$3 million in subsequent biennia
- Funds are to provide “financial assistance to local law enforcement agencies and district attorneys in rural areas to address illegal marijuana cultivation and distribution operations...”
- Grant goes through CJC
- Review and awarding process complete
- 4 counties receiving funding

# JUSTICE REINVESTMENT GRANT FUNDING

- 2013 – 15: \$15 million
- 2015 – 17: \$38.7 million
- 2017 – 19: \$40.1 million
  - \$7 million in supplemental funding for Prison Diversion Programs

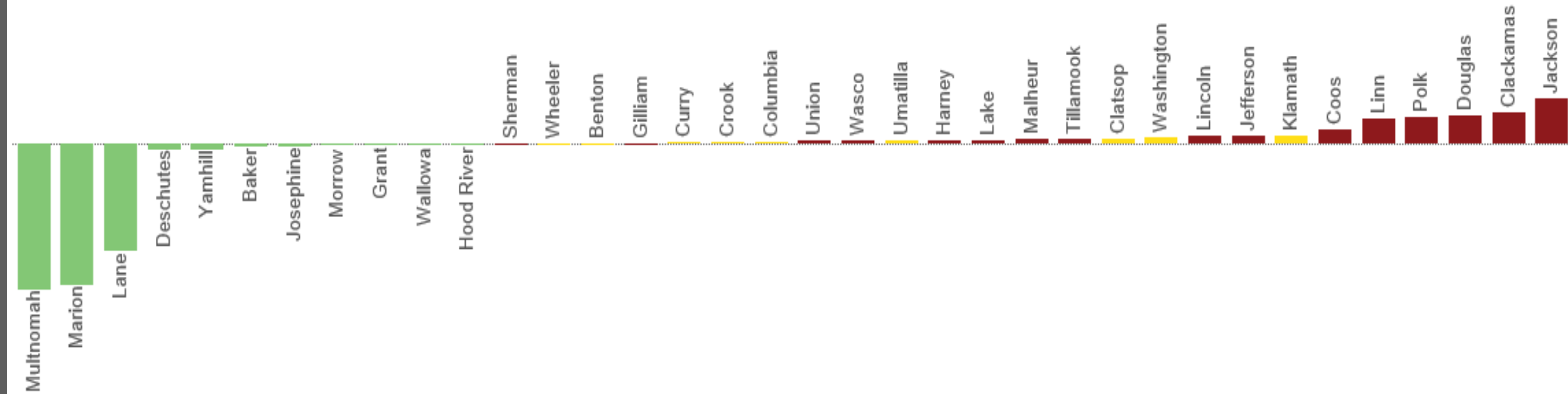


# Updated Justice Reinvestment Dashboards

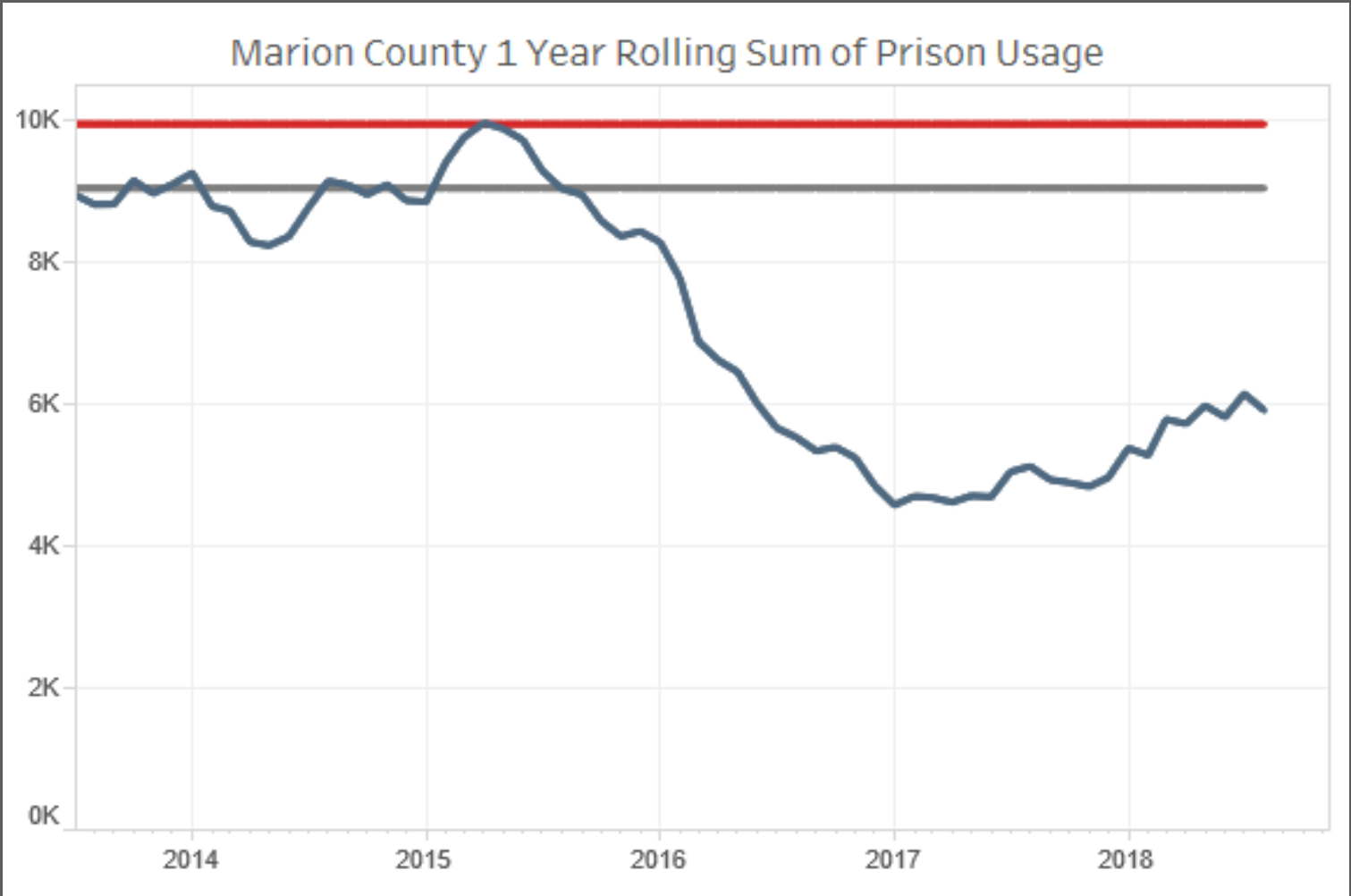
