Measure No: 24-380

Caption: Establish Marion County Extension and 4-H Service District.

Question: Shall District be formed for county Extension programs with maximum rate of \$0.05 per \$1,000 assessed value beginning July 2015?

Summary: If approved, District will serve Marion County in cooperation with Oregon State University Extension Service. The District's purpose is to build a stronger economy by fostering successful agriculture and forestry businesses, healthy youth and families and sustainable communities and natural resources with education services including:

- Applied research for farmers, family forest owners, nursery growers to solve disease, insect, production and conservation challenges.
- Volunteer programs: 4-H, after-school, camps, Master Gardener, Master Food Preserver, food safety, nutrition, Master Woodland Manager, Master Naturalist.
- Small farm development for food supply, community and school gardens, farmers markets, agritourism.
- Noxious weed management to protect city and rural watershed health.

Declining federal and state funding has reduced services throughout Marion County. The District would implement a maximum rate of \$0.05 per \$1,000 assessed value to fund Extension programs. A home assessed at \$160,000 would pay approximately \$8 per year.

The Marion County Board of Commissioners would govern the District with input from citizen advisory committees and Extension. The annual budget and audit will be available to the public.

Contest Total: 1

City of Detroit

Measure No: 24-384

Caption: Five-year Local Option Tax for Contracted Law Enforcement Services

Question: Shall City impose \$1.64 per \$1000 of assessed value beginning 2015-2016 to contract for police services? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary: The City seeks additional revenue over a five year period in order to provide general fund dollars to contract with Marion County to provide law enforcement services. If approved, the City would contract for a deputy to work part-time exclusively for and within the City to enhance the safety and welfare of the local citizenry. Currently there are not sufficient funds to provide any local law enforcement services. Marion County has curtailed its budget following a reduction in federal funding and will not provide any specific dedicated police coverage for the city of Detroit without a paid contract for said services. If approved, the tax would apply to all properties within the city limits, and would generate \$80,039 the first year, and rising incrementally (assuming a 3% increase in assessed value) to approximately \$90,085 in fiscal year 2019-2020. The cost of this levy to a taxpayer owning a home assessed at \$150,000 would be \$246 per year.

Measure No: 24-385

Caption: Bonds for Modernization, Repairs and Improvements

Question: Shall St. Paul School District be authorized to issue general obligation bonds not exceeding \$5,270,000? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: If approved, this measure would construct, renovate, repair and improve district facilities. Specifically, this measure is expected to fund:

- Modernization of the High School Building including construction of new practice gymnasium and multi use area. Renovation and upgrades of girls and boys locker room. Improvements to the Vocational Agriculture classroom. Upgrades to the parking lot.
- Upgrade of the Elementary School heating & ventilation system and electrical system. Modernization and ADA improvements to restrooms. Replacement of windows and floorcovering upgrades.
- Site improvements, furnishing and equipping of projects and bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 21 years. The District estimates that the increased tax rate over 2015 levels will be approximately \$1.42 per \$1,000 of assessed property value.

Caption: Bonds for Security, Repairs, Renovations, Technology and Increasing Capacity

Question: Shall Woodburn School District construct, repair, renovate and improve schools and District facilities by issuing \$65,000,000 in general obligation bonds?

If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: If approved, this measure would construct, renovate, repair and improve district facilities. Specifically, this measure is expected to fund:

- Security/safety features at all schools
- Renovations and additions to address increased enrollment and outdated facilities including classrooms, media centers, gyms, cafeterias, and furnishing and equipping.
- Technology and curriculum upgrades for student learning.
- Portable upgrades, demolitions and replacements including new modular annexes.
- Repairs and upgrades including, but not limited to, ADA, roofing, HVAC and seismic.
- Constructing, furnishing and equipping for Success High School and possible property purchase.
- Property purchase and renovations, furnishing and equipping for District Welcome Center and administrative facilities.
- Site improvements and bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 20 years. The estimated tax rate is approximately \$2.40 per \$1,000 of assessed property value.

Caption: HUBBARD RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Question: Shall the District issue general obligation bonds not to exceed \$780,000? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: If approved, this measure would provide funds for capital costs including:

- The purchase of a Water Tender;
- Refurbish existing fire engine to make safety improvements and increase reliability;
- Replace Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus to meet current safety standards;
- Purchase a Quick Response unit to make efficient use of available staffing;
- Purchase firefighting equipment; and pay bond issuance costs.

The Bonds would mature not later than eleven (11) years from the date of issuance. The measure is estimated to cost taxpayers an average of \$0.33 per thousand of assessed value each year. For the owner of a home or property owner, the estimated annual average cost would be \$33.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.

Question: Shall the District issue general obligation bonds not exceeding \$4,300,000 to improve fire safety and service delivery throughout the District? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: Silverton Rural Fire Protection District No. 2 is seeking voter approval to issue general obligation bonds to finance improvements across the Fire District. Specifically, this measure, if approved would provide funds for capital costs to:

- Purchase and equip firefighting apparatus
- Refurbish 3 existing pumpers to make safety improvements and improve reliability
- Upgrades and safety improvements to existing fire apparatus and equipment
- Replace Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus
- Purchase firefighting and rescue equipment
- Repair and safety upgrades to the Fire District training tower and burn room
- Improvements, repairs to the five (5) District fire stations
- Pay associated bond issuance costs

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 16 years from the issue date and may be issued in one or more series.
