| The Woodburn Fire District (WFD) is seeking renewal of the local option levy at the same rate previously approved by voters. The current levy expires in June 2024. For property assessed at \$200,000 (the average in WFD's service area), the cost of the levy would continue to be \$5.83 per month or approximately \$70 per year. | | | |
| If the levy passes, revenue will be used to maintain the current quality and level of emergency services provided to the district residents and businesses. Funding at this level will allow the fire district to incrementally increase staffing as the area population grows. | | | |
| If the levy does not pass, the fire district's ability to maintain the current level of emergency service and add additional firefighters/paramedics will be reduced. Without additional emergency personnel, response times will increase for medical emergencies, fires, and motor vehicle accidents. | | | |
| WFD provides fire, emergency medical, and rescue services to the residents of Woodburn, Gervais, and the surrounding 75 square mile area. WFD has passed all independent financial audits demonstrating good stewardship of taxpayer dollars. | | | |
