Renewal of Current Three-Year Local Option Tax for City Operations

Shall City continue imposing current \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operating purposes for additional three years beginning 2018-2019? This measure renews current local option taxes.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

The City of St. Paul is annually required to address a variety of important issues including land use planning, housing development, and resource protection. Currently, one full-time employee, limited consultant assistance, and volunteer citizen efforts are addressing these issues.

The City of St. Paul's permanent tax rate provides revenue to the City of approximately \$22,836 a year, which is not adequate to fund the necessary and required functions of the City, including:

- Street lighting
- Police protection
- Land use planning
- Housing development
- Resource protection
- Budget and financial management
- Insurance
- General administration
- Professional services: auditing, legal, engineering and planning

The requested rate will raise approximately \$55,632 in fiscal year 2018-2019, \$60,958 in 2019-20, and \$62,787 in 2020-21.

This measure is subject to the limits of Section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution. The revenue raised will be government purposes other than schools.
