

PARAGRAPH No. 3 Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this order and based on Section 34 (1) (i) of Chapter 604, Oregon Laws 1957, it is further determined and shall be a part of this order that, no livestock districts exist in land subject to the laws of this State which is entirely inclosed by federal lands (as defined by Chapter 604 Oregon Laws 1957), unless otherwise provided by the laws or regulations of the United States.

PARAGRAPH No. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this order and based on Section 34 (1) (j) of Chapter 604, Oregon Laws 1957, it is further determined and shall be a part of this order that, no livestock districts exist in public roads passing through federal land (as defined by Chapter 604, Oregon Laws 1957), unless otherwise provided by the laws or regulations of the United States.

NOTICE OF CREATION OF
NORTH SANTIAM LIVESTOCK DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that the following described area in Marion County, Oregon, comprising more than 2000 acres, has been petitioned for and voted by the voters within said area to be formed into a livestock district to be known as the North Santiam Livestock District, to-wit:

Beginning on the North bank of the North Santiam River at a point 20.00 chains East of the West line of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian, and running thence North along the subdivision line to the North line of said Section 18; thence East $3\frac{3}{4}$ miles to the Northeast corner of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 2 East; thence South along the line between Sections 14 and 15 to the Southeast corner of Section 15; thence East 14 miles to the Northeast corner of Section 24, Township 9 South, Range 4 East which is on the line between Range 4 East and Range 5 East; thence South along said range line 4 miles, more or less, to the North bank of the North Santiam River; thence Westerly along said North bank to its intersection with the North-south line between Sections 27 and 28, Township 9 South, Range 3 East; thence North to the quarter section corner between said Sections 27 and 28; thence West along the center line of Section 28, 29 and 30 of said township and range to the West line of said Section 30; thence North to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW cor. of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 30; thence West one mile to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW cor. of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Township 9 South, Range 2 East; thence South to the North bank of the North Santiam River; thence Westerly along said North bank to the place of beginning.

Notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication, namely November , 1958, it shall be unlawful for Cattle, Horses and other Livestock to be permitted to run at large within the boundaries of said livestock district described above. Violation as outlined in ORS 607.045 is punishable, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$25.00.
