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Know the Facts

- **90%** of Children who are victims of sexual abuse **know and trust** their abuser.
- **95%** of Children who have been sexually abused **don't tell anyone**.
- **95%** of Child Sexual Abuse is **PREVENTABLE**.



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Teach Safety

- **40%** of teenagers have sent or received a sexually suggestive message.
- Talk to your child about your family's values, rules, and expectations.
- Teach your child the dangers of sexting.
- Sexting can lead to bullying and can be a grooming tactic by sexual predators.

Teach Responsibility

- **40%** of children have been bullied online.
- **80%** of children think bullying online is easy to do.
- Have open discussions with your child so they can understand the consequences.

Be Accountable

- Create a social media contract.
- Create screen free times and locations in your home; encourage new activities.
- **Role Play** to help your child understand what they should do if they see, are asked for, or receive sexually explicitly messages.
- **Role Play** to help your child understand how to recognize and respond to bullying.
