

Community Resources Network

The Community Resources Network (CRN) connects resources to people by putting organizations in touch with each other in order to share information that will promote the physical, educational or mental development of children or youth in Marion County, or to provide for the basic needs of children, youth, or families in Marion County. Members use the CRN to share extra resources, seek help with unmet needs, or develop community-wide service-oriented events.

The CRN is free and any organization (non-profit and for-profit) registered to do business in the state of Oregon is eligible to become a member. The CRN complements the 211 system, which helps organizations and community members find services and supports.
