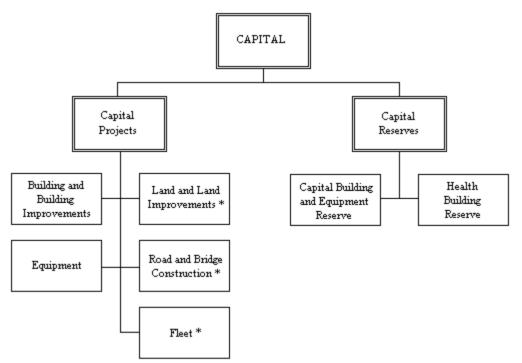

RS Health Building Reserve Program Budget Justification

It is anticipated that another \$5,080 in interest will be earned in FY09-10. The transfer of \$250,000 to the Health Fund is to reimburse the Health Department for the purchase of a home to house residential alcohol and drug treatment services. The Health Department used Net Working Capital to make the purchase in FY 2008-09. The purchase was required to facilitate the transition of services for "Her Place" from a community provider to Marion County Health Department as part of a collaborate plan involving the County, State and community partners to ensure alcohol and drug treatment services to vulnerable populations are maintained.
