- There is a new staff in Woodburn. She is a CADCI working with adolescents and is also bilingual.
- Polk County is growing. The 2nd chance grant has unearthed a lot of gambling issues. Started their electronic medical records.
- Bridgeway will be starting Medical Detox in July. They have a small amount of funding for mentor services for the AIP program. There are also many open positions.
- Scott reminded everyone to make sure that the discharges are getting closed in CIM.

II. Collaboration Between MH and Addiction Treatment – Jennifer/All

- Education to MH Clinicians about UA's and collaboration
- Many MH providers don't take mandated clients
- Try to use UA's to celebrate success not catch people using.

III. Benzodiazepine Policies – Everyone

- CODA handout
- Marion County will not dose over 60 Methadone if they are taking Benzodiazepine. There are letters that go to PCPs to start conversations.
- Bridgeway has run into some patients that refuse to identify a PCP.
- Count pills and do daily dispense are ways to help control the issue
- There is a pharmacy based registry that has been started. However, Doctors may only have access to this.
- Might need to create a policy for outpatient A & D for Benzodiazepine. Scott and Cary will take it to ATOD.

IV. Gambling- Scott/Everyone

- Screening for gambling should be done at intake and should be done again about halfway through treatment.
- Reading gambling questions to the client gets better results than if they answer them alone.
- There is a self assessment workbook. For clients that would not like to go in for an assessment at Bridgeway. The website is <http://1877mylimit.org>
- Treatment is free. Family members can seek services even if the person with the problem comes or not.
