I. Announcements and Introductions

- Clear paths is moving to Compass previously OWITS
- Marion County is starting a Spanish class for restricted drivers licenses in Woodburn
- o Bridgeway opened their medical detox on July 1st. There is 24/7 nursing staff and daily physician rounds. They will accept benzos on a case by case basis.
- o The Polk remodel is almost complete. The remodel added group rooms.
- Scott talked about the survey for evidence based practices. It is for both mental health and addictions. They will need costing also. It is only for priority 1 clients and needs to be completed by July 31st.

II. Funding Changes – Everyone

- o Intoxicated Drivers Program Fund handout
 - In 2011there was a mandated increase in fines for people that get a
 DUII. The money goes directly to IDPF. This fund also allows for
 DUII information only care. Marion County, needs to serve 195 people
 with these funds. Must use IDPF funds before using other indigent
 funds.

- o Reaching Indigent Targets and Strategies Handout
 - People were using various codes. Need to use payer code 65 for indigent fund. Decided to let 01, 13, 65, and 67 be used for termination codes

III. Utilization Management – Triple Aim – Everyone

- o CAPS Special Conditions
 - o The focus is on the People utilizing the most money
 - o Also using things such as SBIRT
- o Increasing capacity as CCO begins to function
 - o Need to increase capacity by 1/3
 - o Need to be able to get people in within 14 days.

IV. Clinical Practice and Outcomes – Everyone

- o The end of Admission/Discharge Data forms era
 - Data forms will no longer need to be sent to Scott. This information can be pulled from COMPASS
 - o Scott will still need the CPMS termination forms.

V. Opiate Crisis: What are we seeing? – Everyone

- o Prescription Opiate Abuse
 - Hospitals are trying to reduce the amount of opiate prescriptions they are writing and limiting the amount given. Looking at it as a public health crisis not a law enforcement crisis.
- o Heroin and Overdoes
 - Heroin is an easy bridge from using opiates. There is an abundance of heroin available in Oregon. Many people turn to heroin because of a lack of resources available or alternate pain management.
 - o There is a prescription monitoring program that has started in Oregon to try and cut the down the problem of pharmacy shopping.
