- Clear Paths had their site review for drug court from Washington DC

II. How accessing detox works: Guest from Bridgeway

- The receptionist screens people out that need to be in the hospital (no benzo detox, methadone, or suboxone treatment)
 - They only give oral medications
 - No IV's
- After the client has been there for a few days the Peer Specialist does an assessment if they want one.
 - After the assessment they create a plan for treatment
- Some Criteria for Admissions
 - Used within 72 hours
 - Have they had Seizures
 - Are they detoxing from Benzos
 - Medications
 - No Smoking Facility
 - Must be able to walk to use the lavatory
 - Don't keep anyone above a .2 blood alcohol they are sent to the hospital
- Need to find out who and under what conditions do places accept patients detoxing off of benzos
- SMG will make time for clinical reviews of individuals that we have had difficulty with or unusual circumstances.

III. Utilization Management – Triple Aim – Everyone

- SBIRT is part of the metrics and will be monitored for the number of screenings they will do for ages 12 and over.
