#### IV. Update Idanha-Detroit Ambulance (progress on sub-contracting agreement)

- The contract has been signed and is in the hands of Lyon's Fire waiting to be signed by the board.
- Things are going smoothly only 2 non injury MVA's not being dispatched, but everyone that needs care has received it.

## V. BOC Work Session

- BOC would like an accelerated timeline so that we are done with the process the beginning of 2012
- They would prefer a renewal vs. a rebid
  - Outside entities can still show interest and will be considered
- Easier process for current providers
  - More extensive process for a new provider to show how they would provide better service and how the current provider is deficient in service.
  - Same guidelines as the previous renewal
- There can be two processes if understanding Gloria Roy correctly.
  - o Also the faster timeline gives less time for outside agencies to bid
  - Not obligated to do any advertising
- Boundaries should be worked out and come to a compromise between the two parties involved. Then a proposal can be brought before the BOC.
  - Doesn't have to be for the whole franchise years. Can have a statement the will relook at how it is working in X amount of years

#### V1. Draft ASA Boundary and Renewal Timeline

- Who is going to evaluate the outside providers that show interest?
  - What is the scoring going to be like
  - o Is this an RFP
  - o It isn't an automatic renewal

- Want to make sure there is a level playing field before the process is started
- Between now and July we need to finish laying out how we want this process to go
- It is pretty much the same as last times process
  - However, this time there has to be consideration if an outside agency shows interest
- Need to make sure that the timeline matches the County Ordnances
- Would like to have the scoring criteria decided by July
- Sherry and Scott will look and see if they can find the documents from the first process and send out to everyone in an email.
