Salem, OR - The Marion County Public Safety Coordinating Council (MCPSCC) is accepting applications to fill one lay citizen position.

The MCPSCC is a statutorily created advisory board, focused on increasing public safety by enhancing law enforcement efficiencies and reducing crime. Much of their work aims to create a continuum of support and services for adult offenders, juvenile offenders, and victims of crime, resulting in a system that emphasizes community safety and prevents criminal activity.

Preference will be given to applicants who bring a diverse set of perspectives, and who will help the council have a more balanced geographic representation among its members.

The MCPSCC meets quarterly in Salem, usually 4:00 – 6:00pm on the second Tuesday of January, April, August, and October.
