Solid Waste Management Advisory Council Seeking New Members

Marion County leaders rely on community members to inform their decisions and policymaking. One way to provide input is to join a Marion County advisory board. The Marion County Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) provides input and recommendations on waste reduction and disposal issues. We are accepting applications for several positions on SWMAC, including:

- Multiple citizen-at-large positions, representing the general public's interests. The ideal applicant has a strong commitment to environmental responsibility that is tempered with environmental practicality.
- One Chamber of Commerce position. Individuals affiliated with a local Chamber of Commerce, either as a member or staff, will be eligible for appointment to the chamber position.

The council meets once a month to develop, review and recommend plans to support an integrated, financially sound waste management system which protects public health and the environment. Meetings are generally held in the evening on the fourth Tuesday of each month. SWMAC members serve 4-year terms, with the option for reappointment.

Applicants should be at least 18 years old and must live or work in Marion County to be eligible to serve on a Marion County advisory board.
