6	WHEREAS, ORS 401.305 provides authority for Marion County to act as an emergency
7	management agency, including authority to establish policies and protocols for defining and
8	directing responsibilities during time of emergency; and
9	WHEREAS, Marion County has enacted Marion County Code Chapter 2.35 pursuant to
10	the authority granted by ORS Chapter 401that provides for executive responsibility in times of
11	emergency and specifically delegates authority to declare a state of emergency to the County
12	Board of Commissioners. If circumstances prohibit timely action of the Board of
13	Commissioners the duties shall be performed by The Emergency Management Board Designee,
14	Chair, Vice-Chair, third member of the Board, Chief Administrative Officer, Emergency
15	Management Director, or the Sheriff (in this order); and
16	WHEREAS, the following conditions have resulted in the need for a state of emergency:
17	Rapidly spreading uncontrolled wild fires in Marion County which are expected to continue
18	indefinitely and have required evacuation; and
19	WHEREAS, the following damage to life and property can be expected from the above
20	conditions: The destruction of structures including dwellings and businesses, animals including
21	livestock, road closures and the threat to persons up and including loss of life.
22	WHEDEAS the entire Countries in a state S
	WHEREAS, the entire County is in a state of emergency now, therefore it is 1 – RESOLUTION
