Annual Blanket Permits

Annual Blanket Work in Right-of-Way Permit Information

An Annual Blanket Permit is a specialty Work in the Right-of-Way Permit that authorizes work in the public right-of-way in multiple locations for a single contractor or sub-contractors for work that does not affect the road structure. This may include such work as utility installation and maintenance, tree trimming and removal, and dust inhibitor spreading. Sub-contractors are required to obtain their own Annual Blanket Permit separate from that of the Public Utility Company (PUC).

Common Questions Regarding Annual Blanket Permits

Q: Who can apply for an Annual Blanket Work in Right-of-Way permit?

A: Any contractor or sub-contractor conducting work in multiple locations within the public right-of-way under Marion County jurisdiction that does not affect the road structure.

Q: What do I need to submit to apply for, or renew, my permit?

A: You will need to submit, at minimum, the following:

- 1) The General Land Development and Event Permit Application completed with all relevant information (Application available on our website under General Documents)
- 2) Updated Certificate of Insurance and Additional Insured Endorsement with expiration date into the following year (Insurance requirements are available on our website under Work in Right-of-Way Documents)
- 3) Company Organizational Information (Template available on our website under Work in Right-of-Way Documents)
