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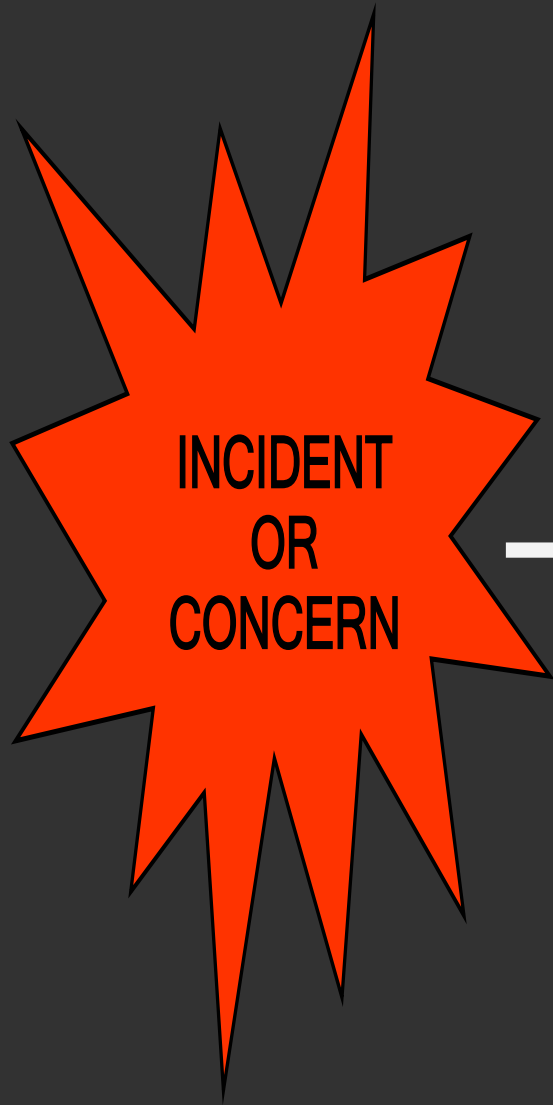

THREAT RESPONSE SYSTEM

A protocol-driven process that addresses:

- Threats of harm directed at others
- Suicidal threats or ideation
- Student sexual misconduct
- Fire-setting behavior
- Adult threats directed at staff or students



PROFESSIONAL DISCUSSION:

Administration and Law Enforcement or Counselor determine need for site based (Level 1) assessment.



LEVEL 1 ASSESSMENT:
(Site Based Team Assessment)

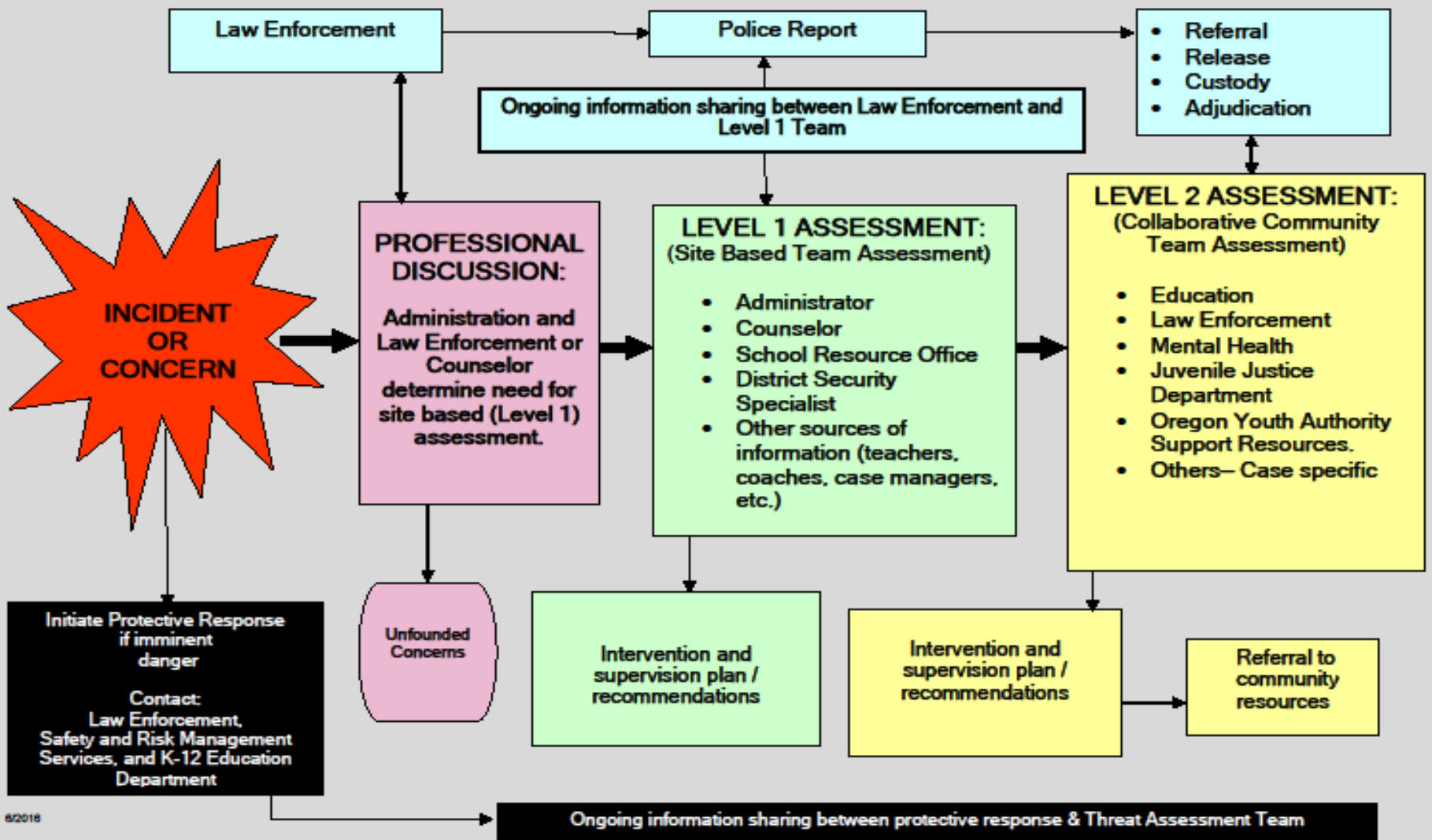
- Administrator
- Counselor
- School Resource Office
- District Security Specialist
- Other sources of information (teachers, coaches, case managers, etc.)



LEVEL 2 ASSESSMENT:
(Collaborative Community Team Assessment)

- Education
- Law Enforcement
- Mental Health
- Juvenile Justice Department
- Oregon Youth Authority Support Resources.
- Others– Case specific

WHAT IS SAFEOREGON ?

SafeOregon is a program created for Oregon students, parents, school staff, community members and law enforcement officers to report and respond to student safety threats.

The goal of SafeOregon is to prevent school safety threats from occurring by providing schools and communities with a relevant tool for reporting potential threats. Tips can be submitted in a variety of ways, including email, phone calls, text, mobile app, or web portal.
