Local Option Levy to Maintain Fire and Emergency Medical Operations

Shall the District levy \$0.35 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for five years beginning 2019-2020 for fire and emergency operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.			
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
Woodburn Fire Protection District provides fire, emergency medical, and rescue services to the residents of Woodburn, Gervais and the surrounding area. District operations are funded through property taxes.			
If adopted, this levy would ensure that four firefighter/medics are on duty each day including a paramedic with advanced life support skills. The District currently has a limited number of paramedics on staff.			
In addition, if adopted, the levy funds would:			
 Provide advanced life support training to select personnel to bring near emergency room level of assistance to patients having a medical emergency. Retain all current firefighter/medics to allow more immediate action to fight fire and save lives without needing to wait for additional responders to arrive. Help the District's ability to cover multiple emergency calls that occur on a near daily basis in the District. 			
For a home assessed at \$160,000, about average for the District, the cost of the proposed levy would be about \$56 for the first year.			
The requested rate will raise approximately \$717,062 in 2019-2020; \$738,574 in 2020-2021; \$760,731 in 2021-2022; \$783,553 in 2022-2023, and; \$807,060 in 2023-2024. The estimated tax cost is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.
