The City of Aurora seeks approval to issue general obligation bonds to finance capital costs of the City including:		
- Improvements to water systems including capacity to better respond to fires throughout the community, pump station on the north side of Mill Creek, and emergency generators for wells.		
- Improvements to wastewater and stormwater systems including replacing storage tank liners and chemical storage facilities.		
- Construction and equipping of a multipurpose building for City Hali, community events, library, and emergency management hub and shelter during extreme weather conditions and natural disasters.		
- Property purchase.		
- Capitalized interest and costs of issuance,		
The principal of the Bonds would not exceed \$7,100,000. Bonds would mature in 21 years or less from date of issuance and may be issued in one or more series. If approved, the average annual tax rate is estimated to be \$2.90 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Actual rates may vary based upon interest rates incurred and changes in assessed value.
