Aurora Rural Fire Protection District

Measure No: 24-484

Caption: Five-year levy for hiring additional firefighters & general operations.

- Question: Shall AFD replace current rate with \$1.98/assessed value for five years beginning 2023, hiring EMTs/Firefighters and enhancing operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.
- Summary: Aurora Fire is seeking a five-year local option tax for general operations. Monies are needed to maintain and hire additional career EMTs/Firefighters. This levy will assist the District to staff apparatus with up to 3 career EMTs/Firefighters 24/7. The District currently has funding for two firefighters per 24 hours, this is below national standards of staffing of a three person minimum crew.

AFD responds to over 1300 emergencies a year, the amount of calls is stretching current resources thin. The reality is that times have changed. Demands on volunteers have become increasingly difficult to balance. We are no longer the small rural district we used to be, we are asking you to decide what service level you want us to provide. Money will be used for staffing, general operating expenses such as equipment, supplies and repairs. This levy request will help ensure we are staffed for your emergency and will put us on target for meeting minimum staffing standards. This levy replaces the current rate of \$0.99.

The proposed rate will raise approximately \$2,208,296 in 2023-24; \$2,284,485 in 2024-25; \$2,353,351 in 2025-26; \$2,423,992 in 2026-27; and 2,496,712 in 2027-28.

Gates Rural Fire Protection District

Measure No: 24-483

Caption: Renewal of current four-year Local Option tax for general operations.

- Question: Shall Gates RFPD retain the option tax of \$.9033 per \$100,000 of assessed value for operations/equipment for another four years? This measure renews current Local Option taxes.
- Summary: Approval of this four-year Local Option serial levy would continue the current fire district levy through June of 2027. The levy would begin July 1, 2023 and would provide funding for the Gates RFPD to maintain the current level of emergency services and meet the fire district's increasing operating costs. Additional revenues would fund the upgrade or replacement of district vehicles and equipment. The proposed rate would generate approximately \$65,561 in 2023/2024; \$67,200 in 2024/2025; \$68,880 in 2025/2026; and \$70,602 in 2026/2027.

Monitor Fire Protection District

Measure No: 3-595

Caption: Local Option Levy to Maintain Fire and Emergency Services.

- Question: Shall MRFD maintain Fire and Emergency Services by levying \$0.50 per \$1000 Assessed Value for five years, beginning 2023-2024? This measure may cause properety taxes to increase more than three precent.
- Summary: Monitor Fire District #58 provides fire and emergency services to Monitor and Yoder and the surrounding areas. Operations are funded through a tax base and proposed local option levy.

If adopted, this levy would enable the District to maintain present service levels and support our Volunteers with Safety and operational equipment. Levy funds would:

- \* Support the cost of new Turn Outs.
- \* Support the cost of 10 new Air Packs.
- \* Support the increased cost of insurance and dispatch cost.
- Support the increased cost of fuel.
- \* Support the cost of replacement equipment
- \* Support increased operating cost.

For a home with an assessed value of \$220,000 (not Market Value), the cost would be about \$110 per year.

The requested rate will raise approximately \$153,942 in 2023-2024, \$158,142 in 2024-2025, \$162,147 in 2025-2026, \$166,890 in 2026-2027 and \$171,443 in 2027-2028.

The estimated tax cost is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessors (Clackamas/Marion).

#### Polk County Fire District #1

Measure No: 27-141

Caption: Five-year local option levy for Emergency Service Operations

- Question: Shall District levy taxes of \$0.78 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years beginning 2024-25 for emergency service operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.
- Summary: Polk County Fire District No. 1 has experienced a service demand increase of 40% over the past two years. In 2022, the District was not able to meet ambulance response standards due to insufficient staffing to meet the increased demand.

The current levy was approved by voters in 2014 and renewed at the same rate in 2019. The Board has attempted not to increase the levy despite increasing costs to provide services and an 85% increase in call volume over the past decade. This levy of \$0.78 per \$1,000 of taxable assessed value would allow the District to:

1: Hire additional Firefighter/EMT's to staff an additional ambulance or fire engine 24 hours a day in order to meet response standards

2: Fund short-term daytime firefighters during the summer wildland fire season when call volume and fire impacts increase

3: Fund the replacement of two ambulances that will reach the end of their service life during the 5-year levy

The levy would raise approximately \$1,349,423 in 2024-2025, \$1,389,906 in 2025-2026, \$1,431,603 in 2026-2027, \$1,474,551 in 2027-2028 and \$1,518,787 in 2028-2029 for a total of \$7,164,270. The estimated tax cost for this measure in an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression, and the collection rate.
