- Zero percent, deferred payment loans

Support of Programs Serving Youth

- Recreation, education, mentoring programs
- Funding for staff or operating costs and supplies
- Must serve at least 51% low to moderate income families

- Programs providing temporary shelter, meals, and support services
- Programs assisting victims of domestic violence and trafficking

Transitional Housing Acquisition

- Non-congregate, transitional housing
- Construction and renovation costs to create housing
- Can be tied to recovery type of services

Improvements to Public Infrastructure

- Funding to improve storm water, sanitary sewer, water, streets, sidewalks, etc.
- Area served by the improvement must be at least 51% low- to moderate-income
