## Please verify the following before calling for the Inspection:

Permits and Plans
<ul> <li>☐ Job address is posted in a visible location.</li> <li>☐ Permit and approved plans are on site and accessible to the inspector</li> <li>☐ Permit information is correct (address, permit number, description of work, etc.).</li> <li>☐ Plans have been reviewed for any special inspection requirements.</li> </ul>
General
<ul> <li>□ Verify that all appliances are installed and working.</li> <li>□ Provide timers for exhaust fans in rooms with bathing facilities.</li> <li>□ Provide installation instructions on site for inspector.</li> <li>□ Provide access to appliances in attic and under floor with min code sizes.</li> <li>□ Verify that exhaust fans have dampers installed</li> </ul>
Appliances
<ul> <li>□ Provide lighting and receptacle at each appliance</li> <li>□ In attics and under floor provide code compliant path and platform</li> <li>□ In garages elevate ignition source 18 inches above floor</li> <li>□ Provide code approved crash protection for appliances in garages</li> </ul>
