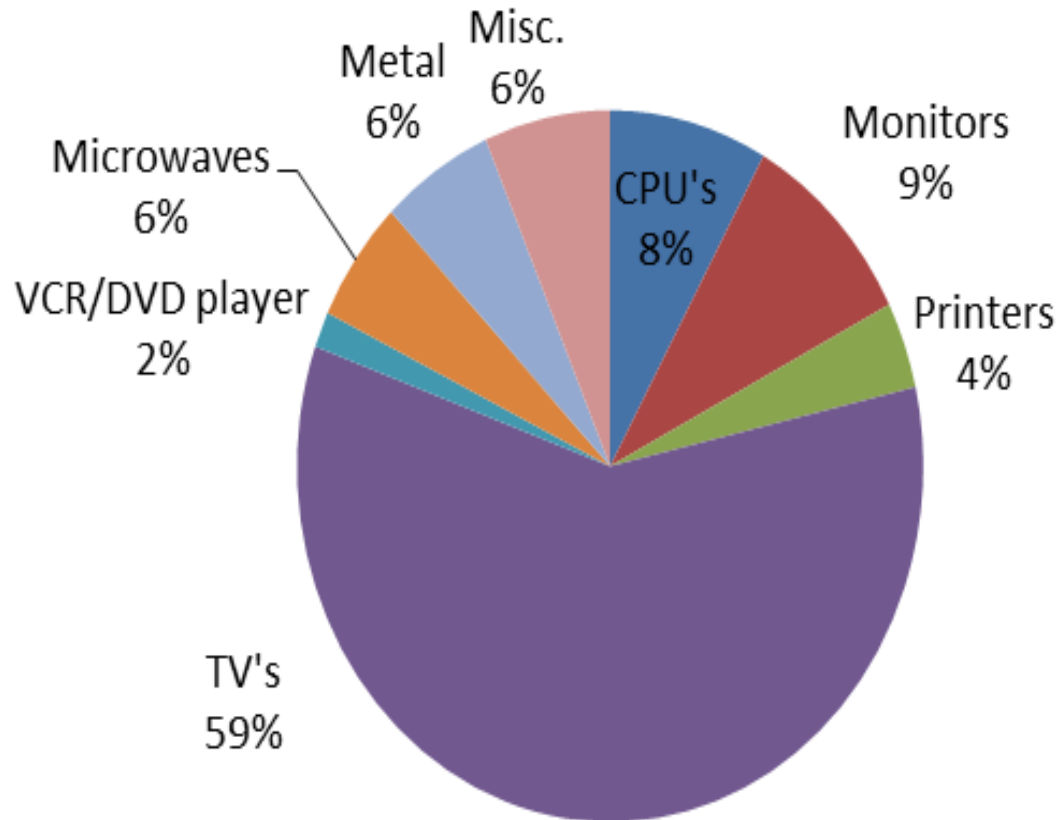
Tons of e-waste recycled: 889 tons (1,763,868 lbs.)

Composition of e-waste (2016)

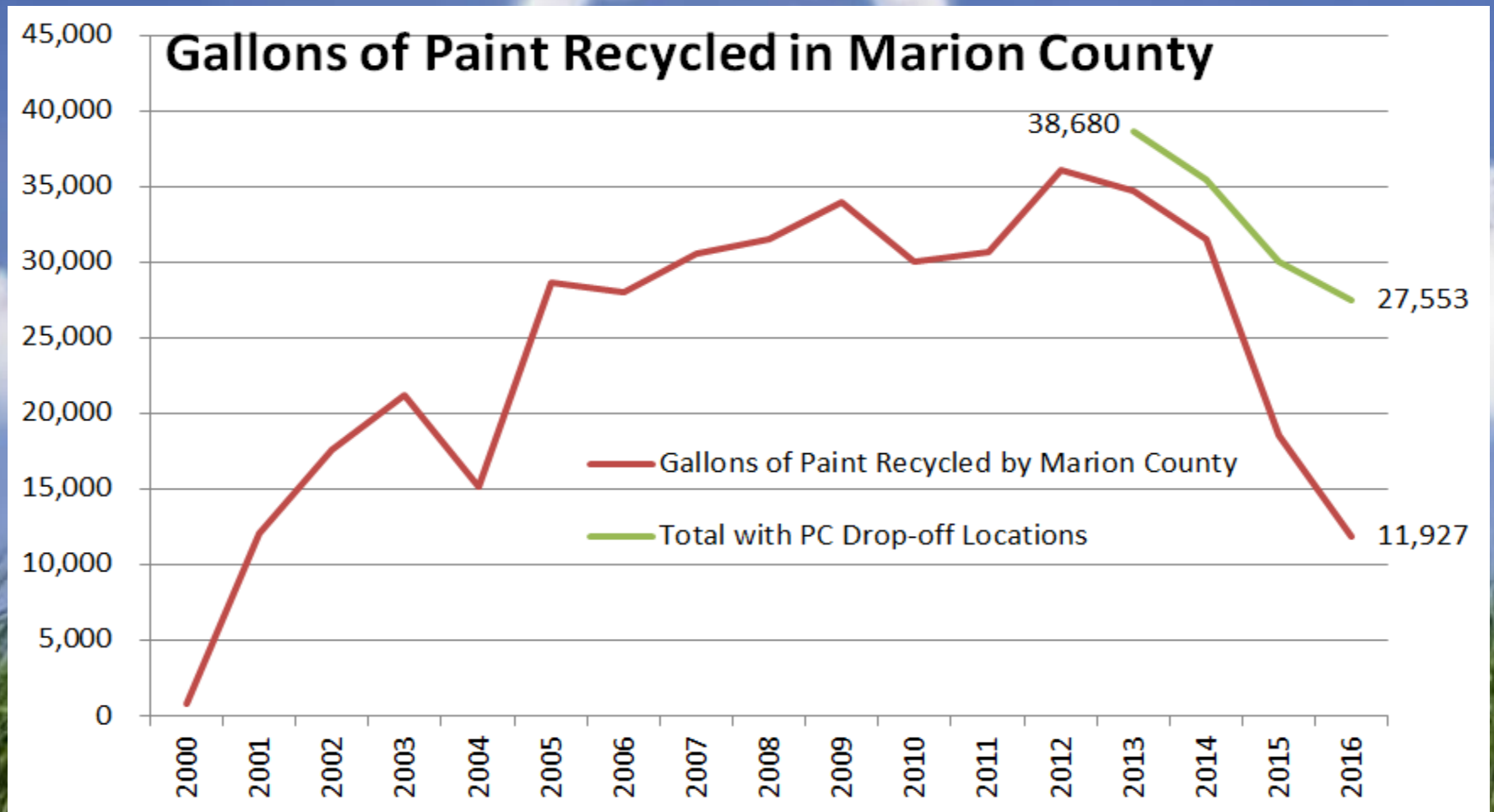
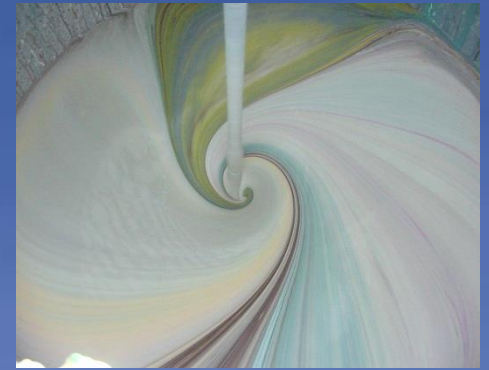




Cell Phones & Printer Cartridges

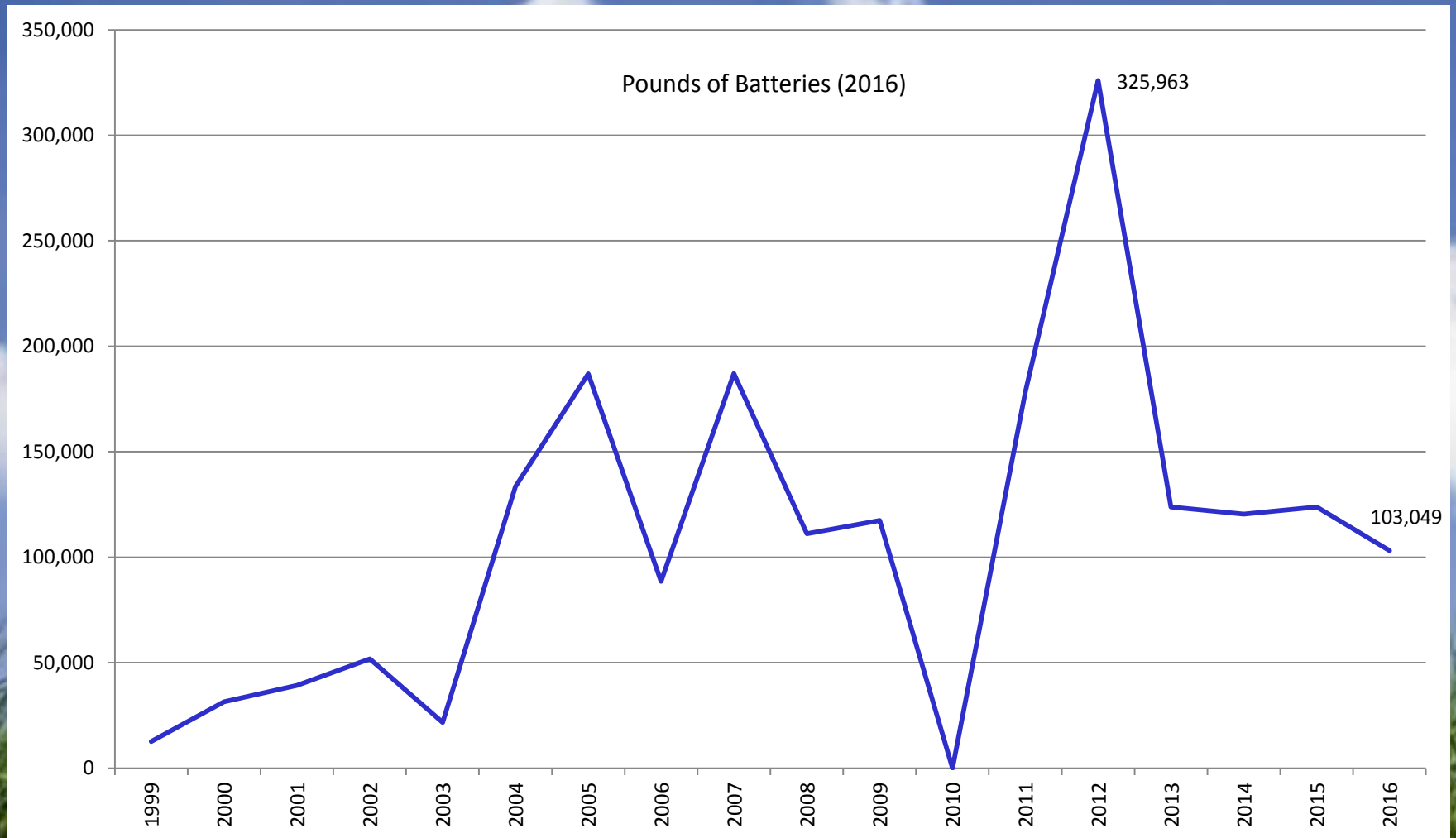

Tons of Batteries Recycled: 51.52 tons (103,040 lbs.) in 2016



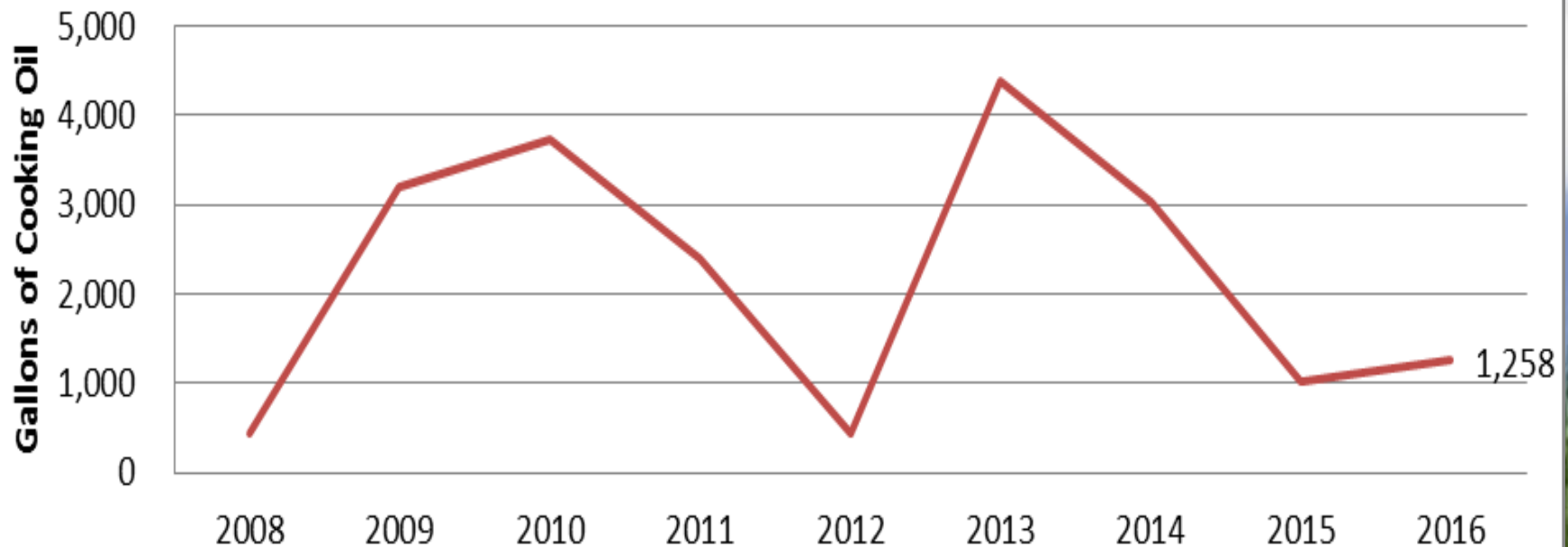

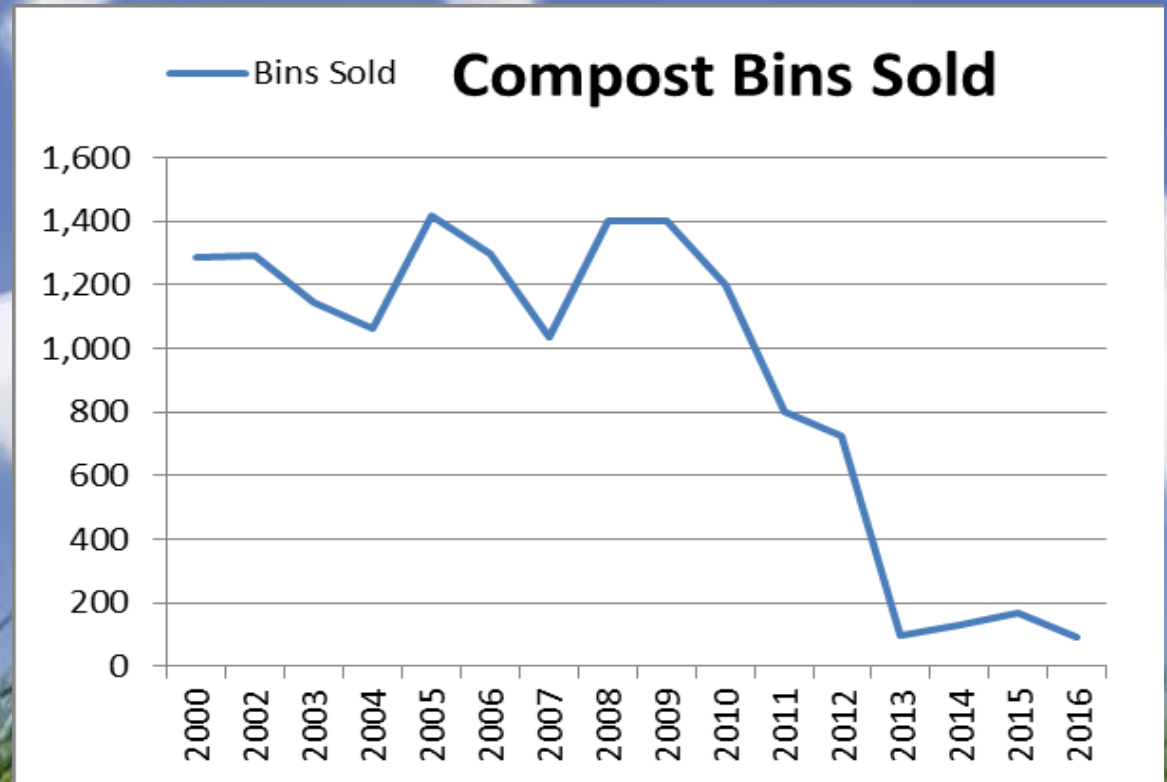


Gallons of Cooking Oil Recycled

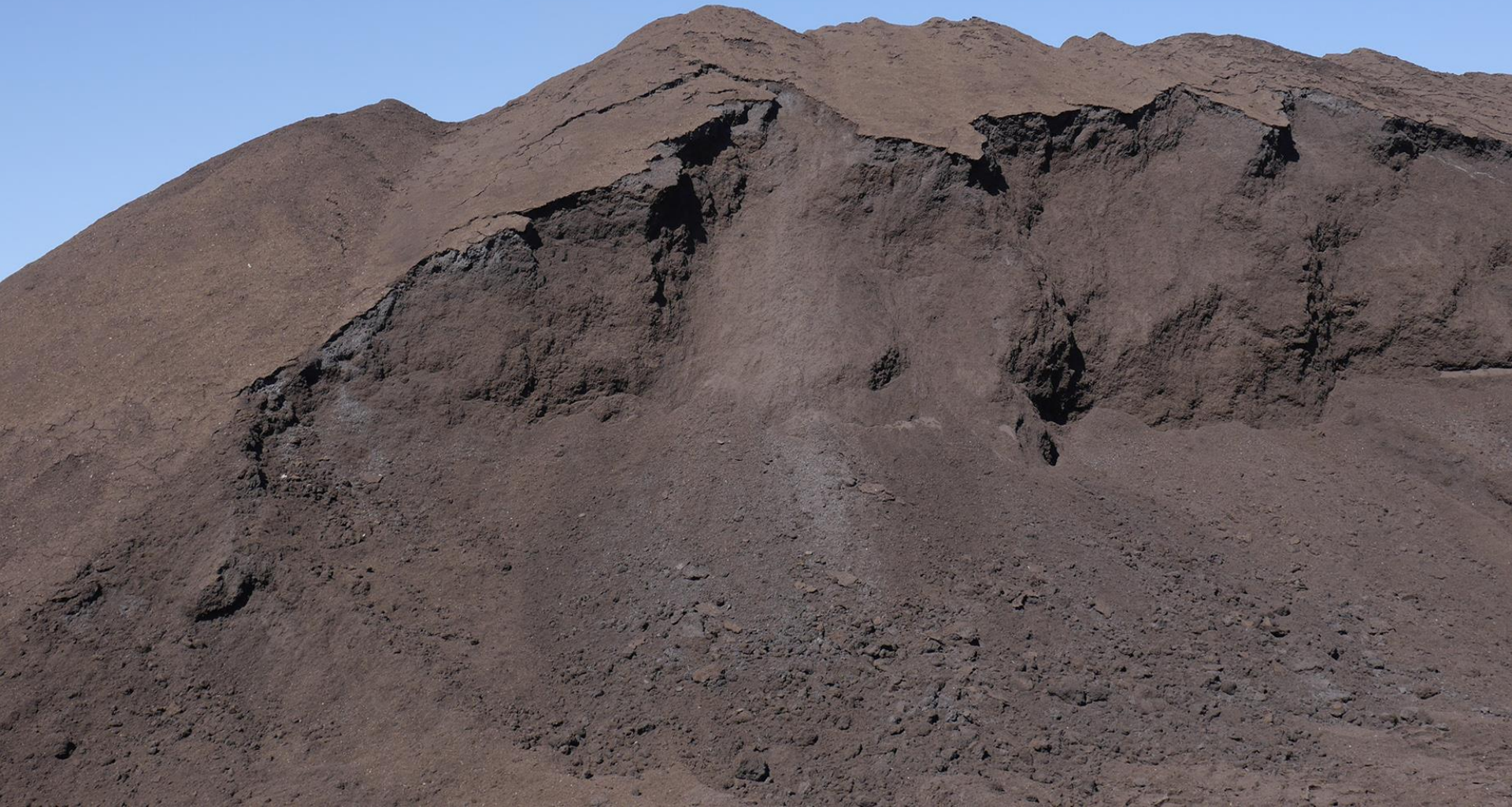

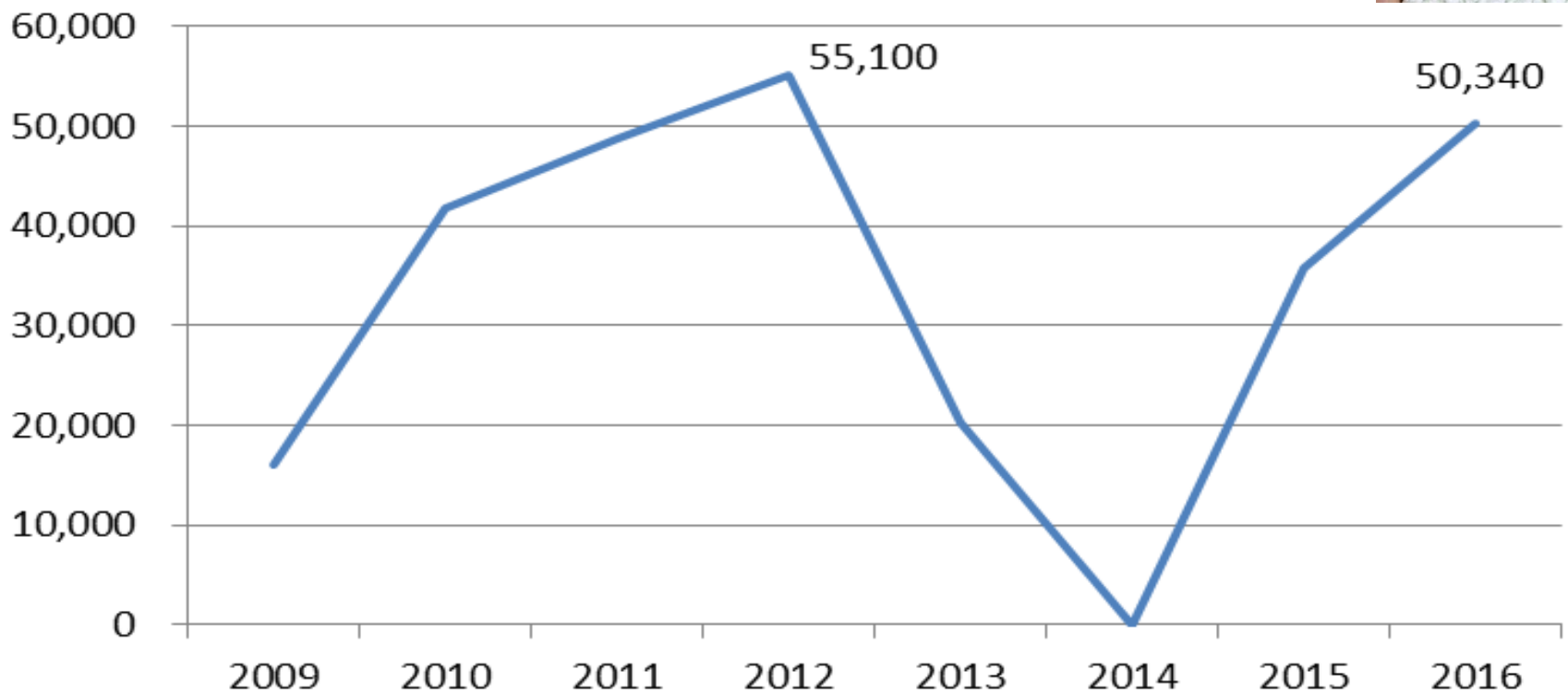

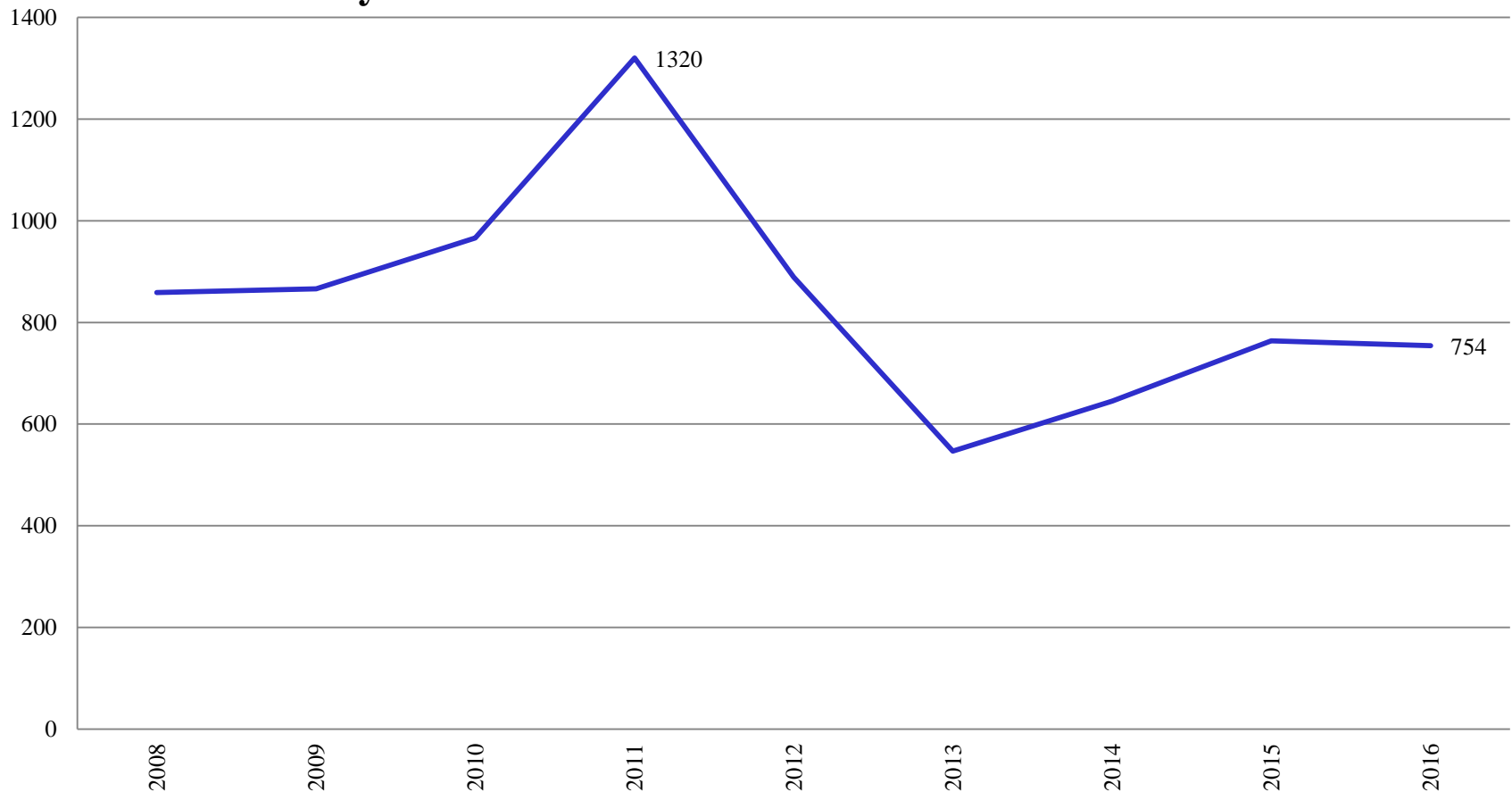
Pounds of Styrofoam Recycled

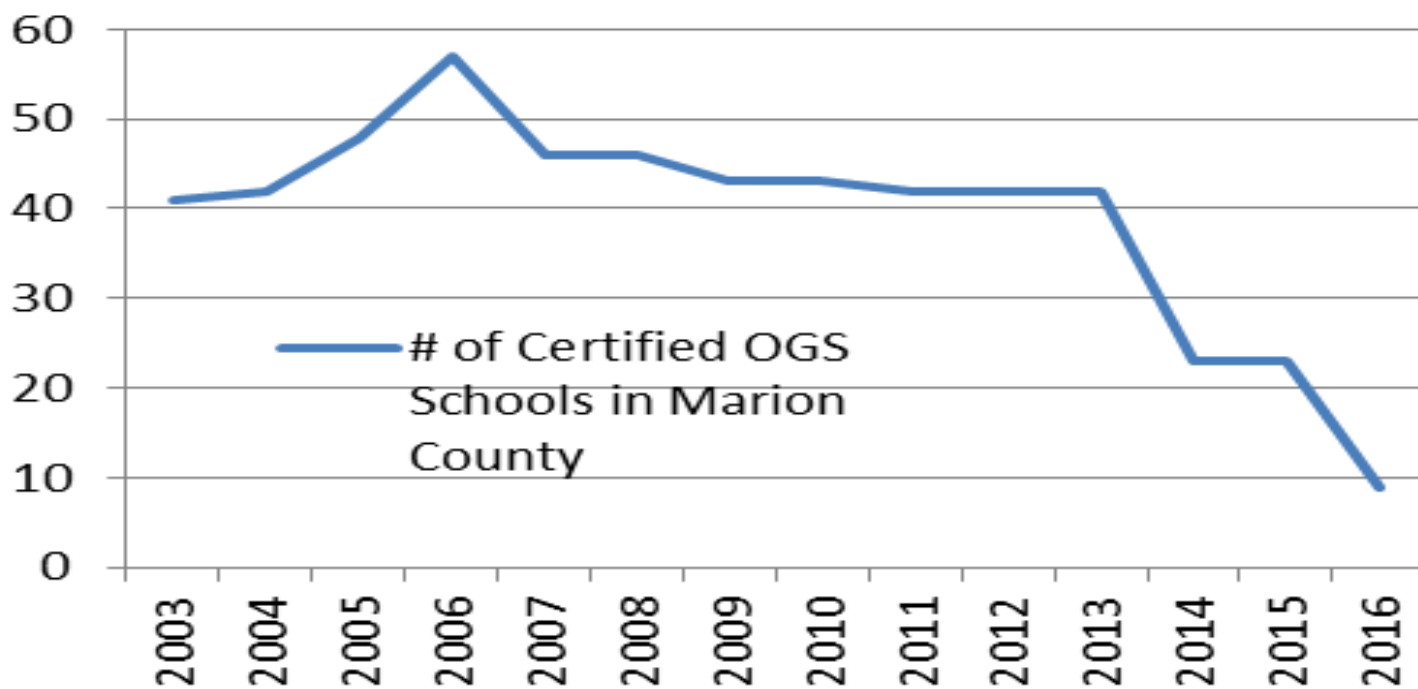
Master Recycler Volunteer Hours



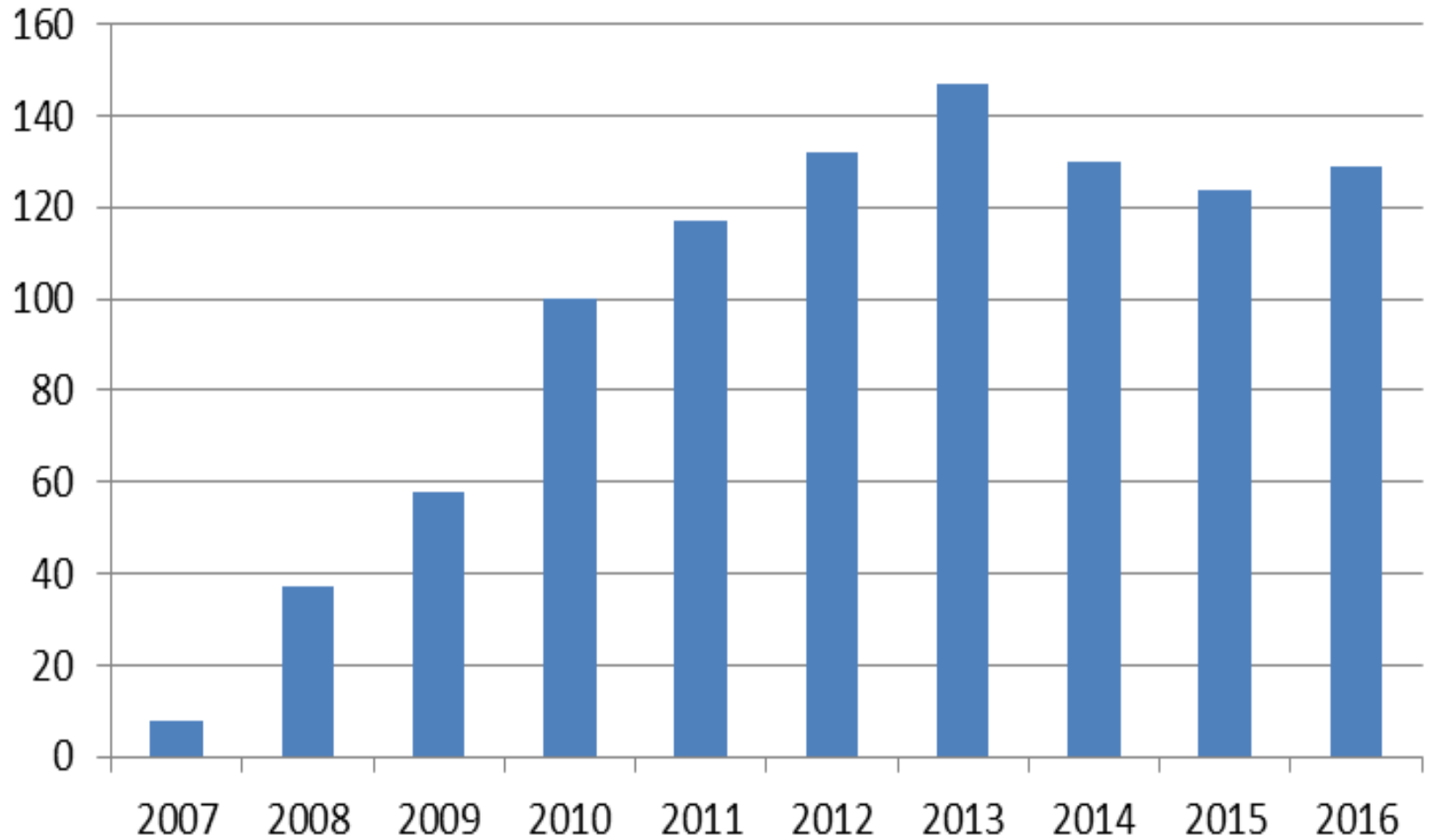

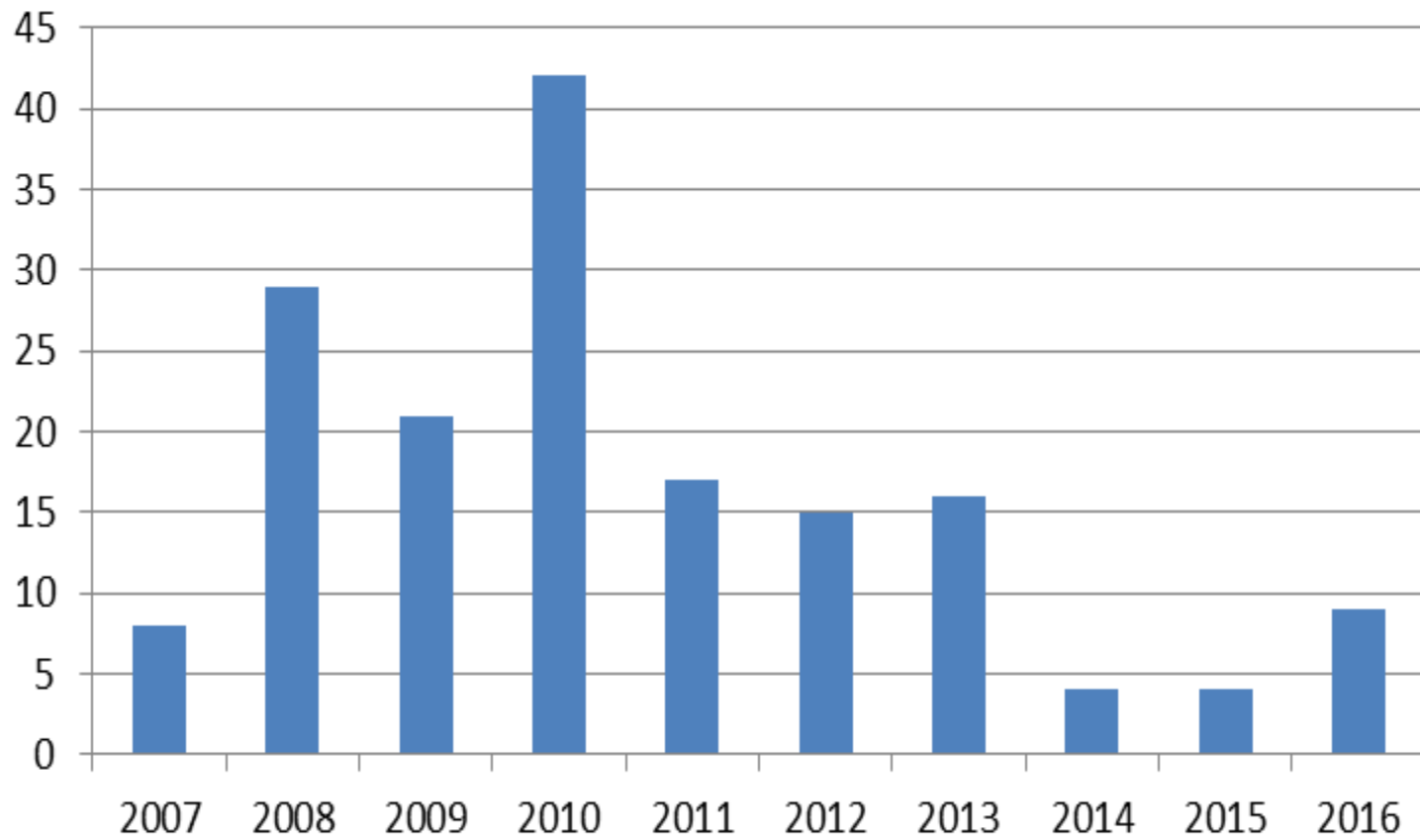
of Certified OGS Schools in Marion County

of NEW EW Businesses



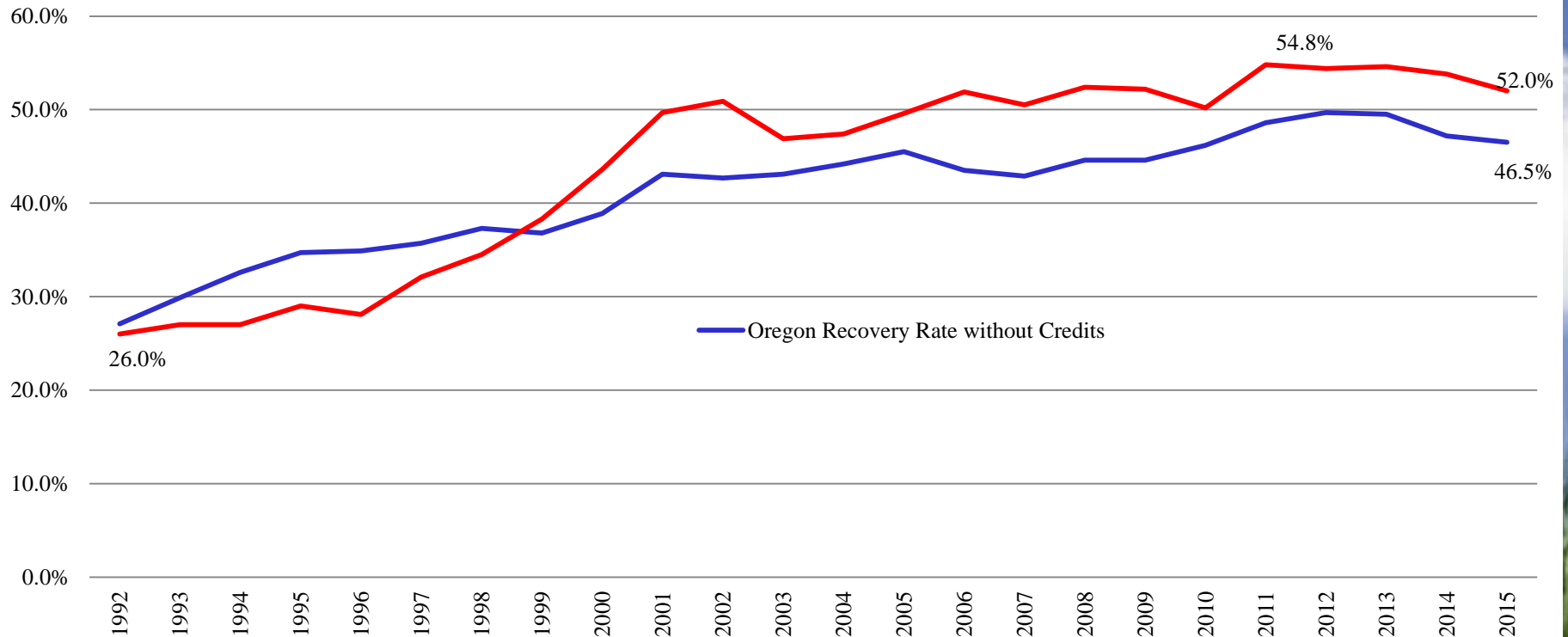


Recovery Rate
