




NORTHERN ESSD

As of today, approximately 90% of the East Salem Service District (ESSD) has street lighting.

The last 10% of lights will be installed where there were previously no electrical poles. The northern section of the ESSD is almost complete, while progress is being made on the southern section. Marion County and PGE met on Monday, July 26, 2021 to assess the remaining streets that need lighting.

Since 2019, Marion County and PGE have been working to install street lights to the residents of the East Salem Service District. In converting the 130 individual lighting districts into a single lighting district, every street will soon have street lights.
