ORDER 08-154

This matter came before the Board of Commissioners at its regularly scheduled public meeting on Wednesday, November 12, 2008, to consider establishing a maximum civil penalty for an excessive noise disturbance violation and a hearing process fee for excessive noise disturbance hearings.

The Marion County noise ordinance provides that the Board will establish a maximum civil penalty for an excessive noise disturbance violation. The noise ordinance also provides that the Board will establish a hearing process fee.

The Board of Commissioner's finds that it is in the public interest to establish a civil penalty and a hearing process fee, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the civil penalty for an excessive noise disturbance violation shall not exceed \$720.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing process fee is established at \$25.00.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall take effect immediately.


